Benefits for the Learner

Competition law prohibits the restriction of competition and the abuse of a dominant position. Competition authorities, at both EU and national level, are working with increased resources to find and investigate evidence of improper behaviour.

If there is a suspicion that your business is engaged in anti-competitive activities, your premises could be searched without warning and your staff could be questioned. This is known as a 'Dawn Raid'.

This course gives you the skills you need to understand the implications of dawn raids and how to handle them effectively.

If your company is found to have engaged in anti-competitive behaviour, you could be fined up to 10% of your turnover. And even if you're found not guilty, you could still be fined if you fail to cooperate properly with competition authorities.

So it's in your best interests to know exactly what you need to do should your business be subject to an investigation. This course will help you to understand the scope of any investigation, what you and your staff need to do to cooperate fully and appropriately and how to minimise the impact of an investigation on other areas of your business.
